Description: Jatish with Flow Labs presented Flow Lab's approach for using AI for signal timing and operations. Chad with Carbyne demonstrated Carbyne's emergency collaboration platform. The platform is currently used by GDOT's 511 program to geo-locate motorists who need assistance. Paul-Matthew from Waycare presented case studies of Waycare's use of ITS data and how data can help detect incidents quickly. Jeff with BrandMotion demonstrated the benefits of retrofitting on-board units (OBUs) into vehicles. He shared lessons learned that BrandMotion has identified to implement CV technology.
