Description: Matt Needham from GDOT presented a play by play account of GDOT's response to the I-16 bridge hit. He showed how GDOT was able to quickly implement a detour, evaluate the bridge, and remove the bridge while causing minimal delays to the traveling public. Charlie from HNTB discussed the I-10 truck parking/availability project. The project shares data between 4 states to help truck drivers find a safe place to park along the I-10 corridor. John Hibbard presented GDOT's V2X program. He showed how and where V2X is being used in GA. Specific examples include freight priority and information near the Savannah port, emergency vehicle preemption, transit signal priority, and SPAT data.
