***Description: In March 2021 GDOT, The ATL, Atkins/Southwest Research Institute, and Kimley Horn partnered to pilot transit signal priority on an Xpress bus route in midtown Atlanta using connected vehicle technologies. One of the least reliable routes, this pilot aimed to see if transit signal priority as a strategy, could be a solution to improve reliability, and if connected vehicle infrastructure could serve as a regional solution for access to signal priority. The team will discuss the overall goals and objectives of the pilot, signal timing strategies for implementing signal priority, and the integration of connected vehicle infrastructure to deliver signal priority.***
