Description: Join ITS Georgia in a virtual format to learn about the Partnership for Inclusive Innovation (PIN), which is fostering access, growth, entrepreneurship, and innovation throughout Georgia. Stephanie Broxton with PIN will provide an overview of the organization, the Georgia Smart Communities Challenge, and will introduce our speakers, Jason Brookins with Clayton County, and Kristen Wescott with the City of Sandy Springs.

Clayton County's Georgia Smart project focused on Smart Pedestrian Planning by building a decision support system for transportation project prioritization that helps promote equity in the community and identifies smart technologies that support walkability. Sandy Springs' Georgia Smart project focused on Transit Signal Priority by working with the MARTA bus service to provide priority bases on published bus location data through an available API as opposed to communicating with on board units.
