Description: Ken Selvig with One Network discussed new and emerging technologies and strategies to turn the tide on the unacceptable work zone crash statistics. Matthew Fowler with GDOT discussed the I-75 Commercial Vehicle Lanes project, part of the Major Mobility Investment Program (MMIP), focuses on improving mobility and safety for freight operators and passenger vehicles by constructing two, barrier-separated, commercial vehicle-only lanes northbound along I-75. Diane Newton from HNTB presented about the I-70 truck automation corridor in Ohio to increase safety, improve efficiency and reduce emissions. Sultan Ali and Dima Poe with CHA discussed using drones and artificial intelligence to monitor traffic conflicts in real-time for work zones.
