Description: Presentations from two winners of the ITSGA ITS Large and Small Projects of Significance awards from 2023.

Gwinnett County won the 2023 ITS Large Project of Significance Award for the continued innovation of their connected vehicle program, featuring the turnkey implementation of connected vehicle safety applications throughout their traffic signal system and the installation of OBUs on agency owned Emergency, transit, and maintenance vehicles.

John's Creek won the 2023 ITS Small Project of Significance Award for the continued improvement of their ITS Network through communication enhancement strategies and in-house design of redundancy projects to improve the sustainability and resiliency of the network.
