**Description: Alan Davis and Natalie Smusz-Mengelkoch with GDOT and ICF presented on the USDOT ITS4US Deployment Program, and how this program will make transportation more accessible for everyone. Dolores Uttero and Anslee Schroeder from GDOT and AECOM presented how ITS is being used through DMS, connected vehicles, and other platforms to improve communications to drivers. Kumari Duvvuri and Christopher Gallien from HNTB demonstrated GDOT's new Safety Data and Crash Reporting Application Programs, and how this will improve existing methods and technologies. Ron Knezevich from GDOT presented new data and validation methods that the department is using with case studies, what data is currently available, and what is expected to become available in the near future.**
